Announcement of new IUCN Green List sites

A total of 16 protected and conserved areas in China, France, Mexico, Peru and Zambia have earned the coveted IUCN Green List status, which certifies that they deliver results for people and nature in a fair and effective way.

The sites who have successfully achieved Green List certification will be announced during a celebration at William Gray Hotel on Saturday 10 December at 6pm.

In addition, H.E. Mr Benoit Charette, Ministre de l'Environnement et de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques, Québec, will share the province's extended commitment to the IUCN Green List in the region.

IUCN will also take this opportunity to celebrate three new strategic partnerships

- A Strategic Partnership with the Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation to support the implementation of the GBF target 3
- A Strategic Partnership with the Korean Ministry of Environment on promoting Fair and Effective Conservation of Protected and Conserved Areas globally based on experience in Asia
- A Strategic Partnership with ESRI, the world's leading supplier of geographic information system (GIS) software, to promote Green List and biodiversity conservation.

The event will include remarks and attendance of senior representatives from IUCN and the World Commission on Protected Areas, the Biodiversity Office of the French Minister of Foreign Affairs, The Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation, the French Development Agency, the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), the Ministry of Environment Republic of Korea, ESRI, the peruvian National Service of Natural Areas Protected by the State (SERNANP), the National Commission of Natural Protected Areas Mexico (CONANP) and the Chinese National Forestry and Grassland Administration
