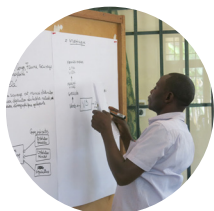
## Capacity development

## Measuring, Reporting and Verification

The MRV concept, applied in the biodiversity and development realm, offers a powerful approach to tackle the translation from science to policy to development by valorising scientific data to feed local and national indicators for reporting and verification of biodiversity policies and strategies.
