Sylvie Goulard has been **deputy governor of the Banque de France since January 2018**. Her portfolio comprises international issues, research, public financial education and financial stability issues, including those related to climate. The Banque is providing the secretariat of the **Network for Greening the Financial System** (NGFS) that coordinates the work of around 120 Central Banks and supervisors committed to tackle climate related financial risks and encourage sustainable development. Within the NGFS, Mrs Goulard co-chairs the Task Force on nature-related risks.

She is a member of the *One Planet Lab*, a global high-level group advising President Macron on sustainable development, including finance and biodiversity. During the pandemic, she was a member of the Pan-European Commission on Health and Sustainable Development launched by the WHO-Europe.

After the presidential election in 2017, Mrs Goulard was Minister of Defense. From 2009 to 2017, she served as a member of the European Parliament (ECON Committee). She was a political advisor to Romano Prodi during his time as President of the European Commission.
